Thank you for submitting your Smoke-Free Management Plan for the Burnie Show and Agri Expo, which will be held in Ridgley on October 4th and 5th, 2024.

I have assessed your plan, and based on the information provided, I approve your plan. If you require a Places of Assembly Licence, this Smoke Free Management Plan must be sent to Council along with your Place of Assembly licence application.

Events are no longer regulated by specific COVID-19 Public Health Guidelines. *Guidelines for COVID-19 safety at events* have been revoked and events can proceed without requirements to submit and gain approval of an Event COVID-19 safety plan.

However, with COVID-19 continuing to circulate within the community, it remains important to act to reduce the spread of COVID-19 at events. To achieve this, event organisers are <u>encouraged</u> to implement the advice contained in Public Health Guidance - *COVID-19 safety at events*.
