EMERGENCY REPORTING AND EVACUATION PROCEDURES

Types of emergencies to be reported to site personnel are:

- MEDICAL (Urgent call 000 then St Johns On-Site)
- FIRE (000 then Security)
- SEVERE WEATHER
- BOMB THREAT (000 Then Security)
- Extended Power Loss
- TERRORIST ACTIVITY (000 Then Security)



MEDICAL EMERGENCY

• Call medical emergency phone number

St Johns On Site Ambulance 000 Fire Department 000 Police 000

Provide the following information:

- A. Nature of medical emergency,
- B. Location of the emergency and
- C. Your name

«Do not move victim unless absolutely necessary.

«Call the following personnel trained in CPR and First Aid to provide the required assistance the arrival of the professional medical help:

St Johns On Site

«Before First Aid arrives, as a minimum, attempt to provide the following asistance

Stop the bleeding with firm pressure on the wounds (note: avoid contact with blood or other bodily fluids).



FIRE EMERGENCY

When fire is discovered: Notify the local Fire Brigade by calling 000

Fight the fire ONLY if:

- The Fire Brigade and Security has been notified.
- The fire is small and is not spreading to other areas.
- Escaping the area is possible by backing up to the nearest exit.
- The fire extinguisher is in working condition and personnel are trained to use it.

Upon being notified about the fire emergency, occupants must:

- Leave the building using the designated escape routes.
- Assemble in the designated area (specify location):
- Remain outside until the competent authority (Designated Official or designee) announces that it is safe to re-enter

Designated Official, ALL CHIEF STEWARDS

- Coordinate an orderly evacuation of all people in the Marquee
- Report any problems to the Emergency Coordinator at the assembly area.

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Assistants to Physically Challenged should:

• Assist all physically challenged employees in emergency evacuation
